At its centre is the Serenity Spa, where a thermal suite of sauna, steam, jacuzzi, and heated indoor pool sits alongside the treatment rooms. The spa's holistic therapies reach beyond the physical: the Reiki Healing Journey and Serenity Holistic Journey work with energy and stillness, while the Ancient Greek Massage and Aphrodite's Hot Stone Massage draw on the island's own traditions.

Nourishment follows the same instinct. Around a third of the menus across the resort are plant-based, and Seashells Healthy Living sets an entirely vegan table by the sea, built on seasonal Cypriot produce and the Mediterranean diet. Sea-view rooms, open to the light and the sound of the water, offer what rest needs: space, quiet, and time.

That motto reaches well past the guest experience. Radiate Kindness shapes how the resort treats its team, its neighbours, and the world beyond the gate. St Raphael supports

charities including the World Food Programme, the Cyprus Anti-Cancer Society, and Voice for Autism Cyprus, and invites guests to add an optional one-euro donation at check-out toward its community work. Its gardens, among the largest in Limassol, are also home to a community of resident cats cared for by the team, long a cherished part of what makes the place its own.

"We believe that kindness is at the heart of every healing journey. Joining Healing Hotels of the World reflects our commitment to creating experiences that inspire wellbeing, connection, and renewal," says Farah Shammas, Managing Director, St Raphael Resort & Marina.

"St Raphael brings a distinctly Mediterranean expression of healing to our collection, one measured in unhurried days and time spent by the sea rather than in fixed programmes.
